ORDER

In the order read first paper above, Government ordered that the teacher-student ratio would be revised from 1:45 to 1:40 in the schools affected by the problem of division fall for the limited purpose of accommodating the teachers rendered surplus for the year 1997- 1998. Since then, this benefit is extended every year. As per the Government order read 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, the said benefit was extended for the year 2010-11 also.

2. As per the G.O. read 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, Government, in principle, accepted the package for the introduction of a scientific method of recruitment of teachers in Aided School sector and the deployment of existing excess teachers. This is now under the consideration of Government and orders in this regard will be issued shortly.

3. Several representations requesting to extend the benefit of 1:40 teacher-student ratio to academic year 2011-12 have been received in Government.

4. Having examined the case in detail, Government are pleased to order that the benefit of 1:40 ratio is extended to the teachers in schools affected by the division fall for the academic year 2011-12 or till the implementation of

the new package, whichever is earlier, as a special case. This benefit is limited for the purpose of accommodating teachers rendered surplus subject to the condition that no additional post of teachers will be created on this account.

5. The Educational Officers concerned will revise the staff fixation orders accordingly.

6. Government are pleased to extend the benefit of 1:40 teacher-student ratio to the Specialist Teachers also as in the case of mainstream teachers as a special case, during the academic year 2011-2012 or till the implementation of the new package whichever is earlier. 10% reduction from the required number of students (mandatory) is allowed so as to retain regular Specialist Teachers who are rendered surplus due to division fall subject to the condition that no additional posts will be created.


