

## ***General Instructions***

1. Affix your passport size photo on the Admission card in the space provided and attest the photo by the Head of the Institution in which you are studying.
2. Reach the examination centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. DO NOT take calculator, mathematical & physical table or any other kind of ready reckoner to the examination hall.
4. Open the question booklet only after getting proper instruction.
5. Question paper contains two parts, Part (A) and Part (B).
6. Part (A) contains 20 questions of 1 score each and Part (B) contains 10 questions of 3 score each.
7. Write the answer of each question only at the space provided for it.
8. Explanations are not required for the answers to the questions in Part (A)
9. For questions under Part (B), detailed explanations are required. For doing calculations, the last page of the booklet may be used.
10. Mathematical instrument box is not permitted in the examination hall.
11. Don't discuss the doubts with others during the examination time.
12. Use only ink pen/ball point pen with blue/black ink for writing the answer. Figures in answer should be drawn with pen only.
13. Candidates are permitted to leave the examination hall only after the examination time is over.
