PREFACE

Kerala's educational landscape features a diverse mix of state and national curricula. This report '**An Overview of Affiliated Schools Outside the Kerala State Education Board**' offers a detailed statistical analysis of the state's recognized CBSE and ICSE institutions. By documenting the scale and reach of these national-stream schools, this report serves as an essential guide to understanding the growing demand for diverse pedagogical approaches in Kerala.

This report provides a detailed statistical analysis of schools in Kerala affiliated with boards other than the state education board, excluding international schools. The analysis focuses on schools under the CBSE and ICSE frameworks. The CBSE sector is further examined through three distinct pillars: **Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNV)**, **Kendriya Vidyalayas (KV)**, and **Independent CBSE schools**. Using a granular, district-wise lens, the study evaluates critical parameters, including school density and the demographic profiles of students and staff. With a strong commitment to inclusivity and equity, the data is disaggregated by gender and social groups to track academic progression from Lower Primary through Higher Secondary levels.

This report serves as a vital resource for policymakers and stakeholders to understand the reach of national-stream education in Kerala. While every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy and reliability of the information presented, the findings are subject to the limitations of the available data. I would like to acknowledge and appreciate the dedicated efforts of the Statistical Division staff involved in the preparation of the report.

It is hoped that this report will offer useful insights into the status of CBSE and ICSE institutions across Kerala, shedding light on the distinct roles played by JNVs, KVs, and independent schools. By providing this detailed, district-wise understanding of school density, demographics, and student progression, we hope to contribute to informed decision-making that furthers equity and inclusivity in the state's evolving educational landscape.

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1. Introduction

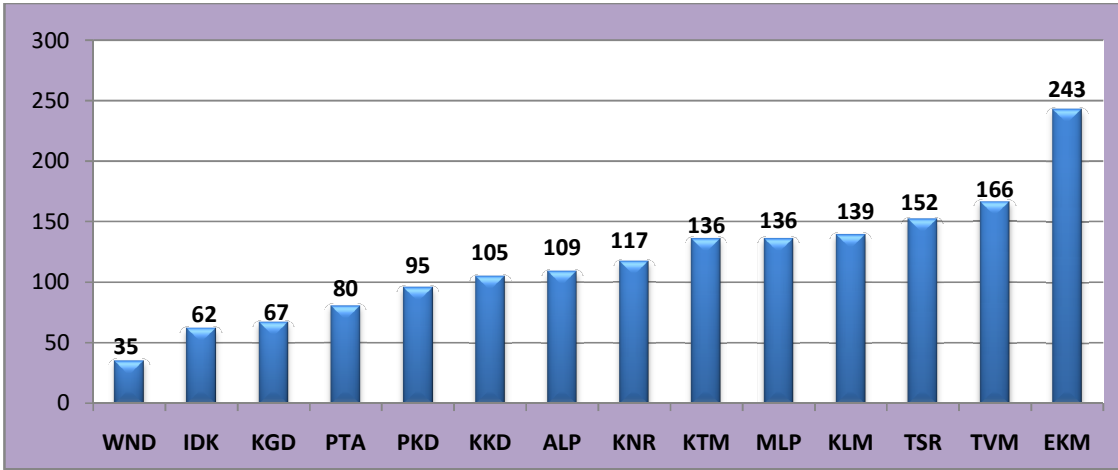
In Kerala, while the majority of schools follow the SCERT (State Council of Educational Research and Training) syllabus, there are a significant and growing number of institutions affiliated with national and international boards. While the State Syllabus remains deeply rooted in local culture and provides a strong foundation for state-level opportunities, national and international boards serve as "gateways." They provide students with the specific linguistic, analytical, or standardized tools needed to compete on a broader national or global stage.

While the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) serves as the primary alternative to the State syllabus in Kerala, a diverse educational landscape is maintained by several other recognized boards. This includes a significant number of schools under the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), which offers the ICSE (Class 10) and ISC (Class 12) qualifications. The national frameworks represent a significant segment of the state's educational choices, this report focuses specifically on the institutional profiles and distribution of schools affiliated with the CBSE and ICSE boards. This report focuses on CBSE- and ICSE-affiliated schools, covering grades I through XII; international schools fall outside the scope of this study.

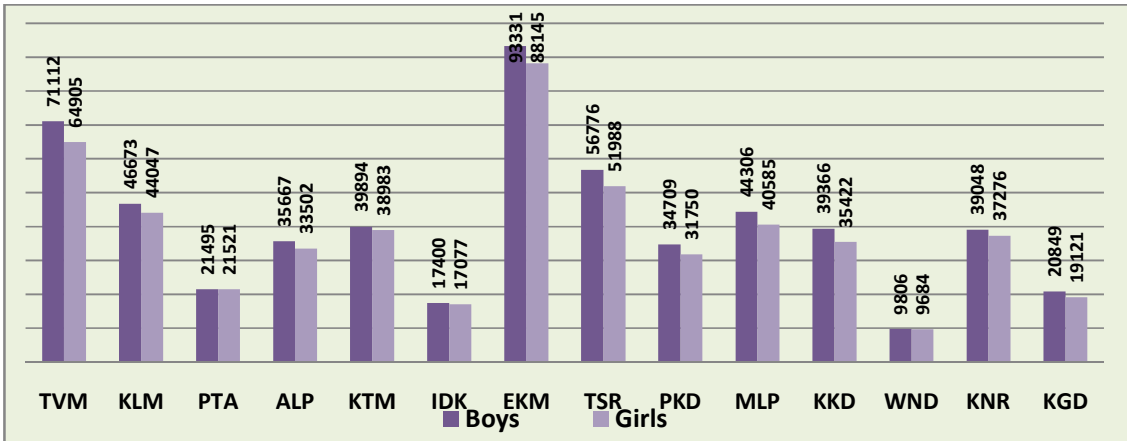
Within the non-state syllabus sector in Kerala, there are **1,642** educational institutions affiliated with the CBSE and ICSE boards. These institutions collectively cater to a student population of **1,104,438 [1012698 (I-X) - 91.69% , 91740 (XI-XII) - 8.3%]** supported by a professional workforce of **58,710** teachers. A comprehensive district-wise statistical breakdown of these figures is provided in the table below.

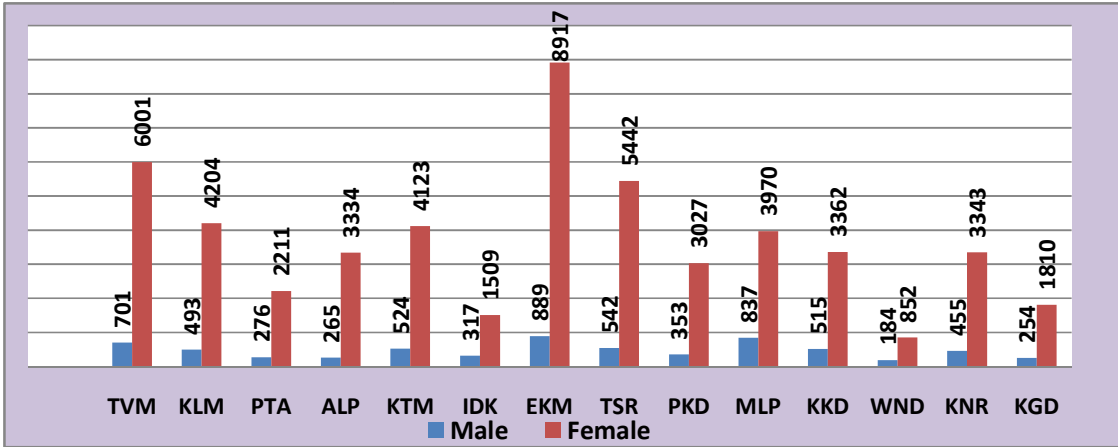
The data reveals a total of **1,642** schools following a non-state syllabus. There is a significant disparity in how these institutions are distributed geographically. Ernakulam (EKM) stands out as the primary educational hub with 243 schools, accounting for nearly 15% of the total institutions. In contrast, Wayanad (WND) has the lowest presence with only 35 schools. This suggests a heavy concentration of non-state syllabus education in urban or economically developed centers like Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) and Ernakulam, while high-range or rural districts like Idukki (IDK) and Wayanad remain underserved.



Regarding student enrollment and gender demographics, the collective student body across these institutions totals **1,104,438**. The data indicates a slight gender imbalance, with 570,432 boys compared to 534,006 girls. Ernakulam (EKM) maintains the highest student concentration with 181,476 individuals, followed by Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) with 136,017. Conversely, Wayanad (WND) accounts for the lowest volume of students, recording just 19,490. While the regional trend generally leans toward highermale enrollment, Pathanamthitta (PTA)demonstrates nearly perfect gender parity with 21,495 boys and 21,521 girls. Notably, Pathanamthitta is the only district in the dataset where female enrollment actually exceeds male enrollment, albeit by a marginal difference of only 26 students.



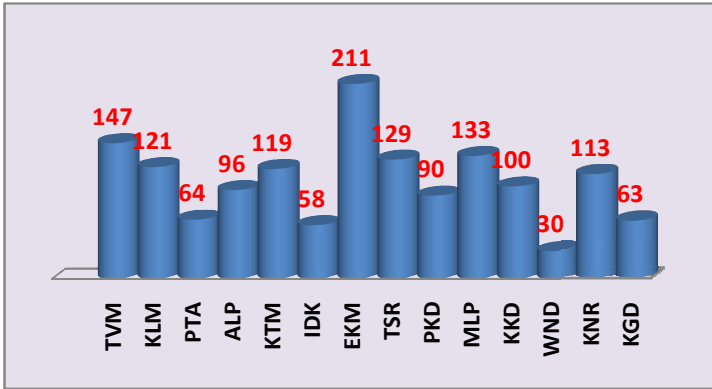
The workforce supporting these institutions consists of a total of **58,710** teachers. The most striking aspect of the faculty data is the overwhelming gender imbalance in favor of female educators, with 52,105 female teachers compared to only 6,605 male teachers. This means that roughly 88.7% of the teaching staff across these schools are women. In Thiruvananthapuram, for instance, female teachers (6,001) outnumber males (701) by more than eight times. This trend is consistent across all districts, highlighting that the non-state syllabus education sector is a female-dominated profession in this region.



The succeeding paragraphs give an exclusive analysis of educational institutions affiliated with the CBSE and ICSE boards.

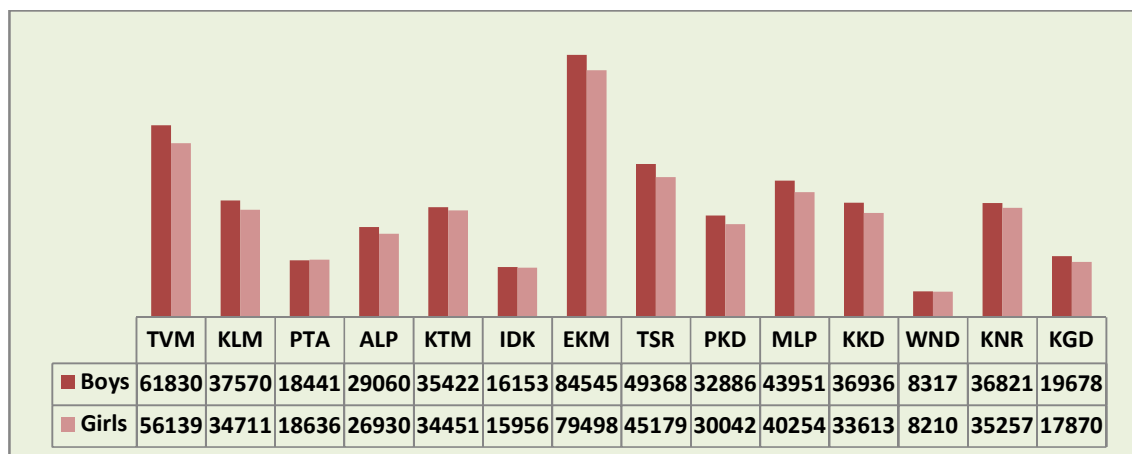
2. Educational Institutions affiliated with CBSE Boards.

The provided data offers a comprehensive overview of the CBSE educational landscape in Kerala, detailing a robust network of **1,474** schools. These institutions serve a total student population of **987,724**, maintained by a dedicated workforce of **52,755** teachers. A district-wise analysis reveals that Ernakulam serves as the primary hub for CBSE education, leading the state with 211 schools and the highest student enrollment of 164,043. Conversely, Wayanad represents the smallest footprint with only 30 schools and 16,527 students. The data also highlights a significant gender distribution within the faculty; of the total teaching staff, approximately 88% are female (**46,663**), compared to just 12% male (**6,092**). Overall, the student population shows a relatively balanced gender ratio, with **510,978** boys and **476,746** girls enrolled across the state's CBSE affiliated institutions



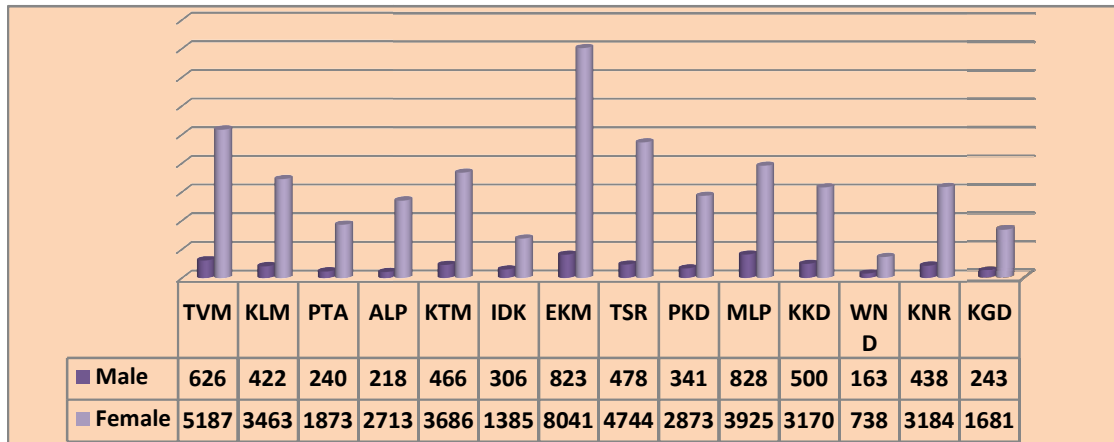

The student body across Kerala's CBSE-affiliated schools is characterized by a massive enrollment of **987,724** students, reflecting the curriculum's significant footprint in the state. A detailed breakdown reveals a total of **510,978** boys and **476,746** girls, indicating a relatively balanced gender distribution with a slight male majority. Geographically, student concentration is highest in Ernakulam, which leads the state with 164,043 students, followed by Thiruvananthapuram with 117,969. These two districts are the only ones to surpass the 100,000-student mark, contrasting sharply with Wayanad, which records the lowest enrollment at 16,527 students. Other significant enrollment centers include Thrissur (94,547) and Malappuram (84,205), while high-altitude or smaller districts like Idukki (32,109) and Pathanamthitta (37,077) maintain much lower student populations. Overall, the data illustrates a robust and widely distributed student population that is most densely clustered in Kerala's urban and commercial hubs.



The teaching faculty within Kerala's CBSE-affiliated schools is composed of a total of **52,755** teachers. A profound gender imbalance characterizes this workforce, with

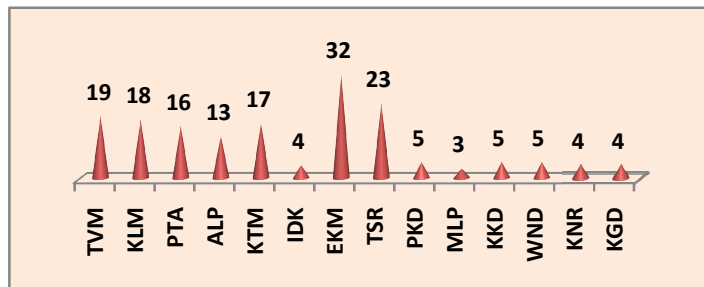
46,663 female teachers (approximately 88.5%) compared to **6,092** male teachers (approximately 11.5%). Geographically, the distribution of staff closely mirrors student enrollment trends, with Ernakulam employing the largest faculty of 8,864 teachers, followed by Thiruvananthapuram with 5,813 and Thrissur with 5,222. In contrast, Wayanad has the smallest teaching community with only 901 members. On average, the teacher-student ratio across the state stands at approximately one teacher for every 18.7 students, though this varies by district. The highest concentrations of male teachers are found in Malappuram (828) and Ernakulam (823), while Wayanad and Alappuzha record the lowest numbers of male faculty members at 163 and 218 respectively.



3. Educational Institutions affiliated with ICSE Boards.

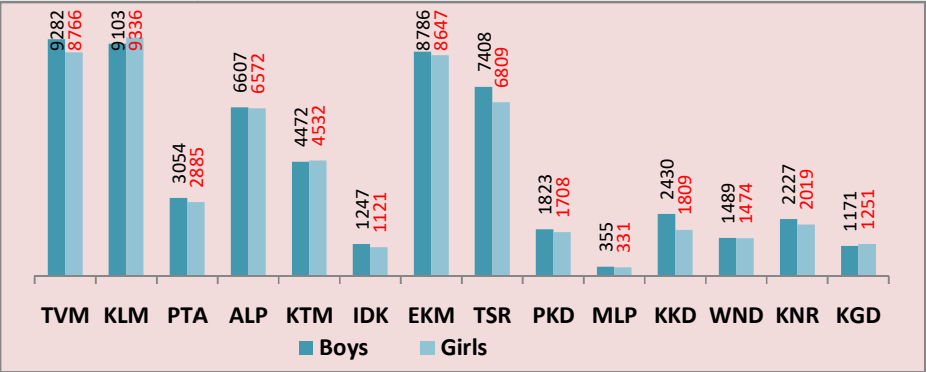
ICSE schools in India represent a distinct and highly regarded segment of the nation's education system. The Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) examination is conducted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE), a private board established in 1986 in India. CISCE designs its examinations in the general education course according to the recommendations of the New Education Policy 2020. The Indian School Certificate (ISC) examination is also conducted by CISCE, specifically for Class 12 students. Today, CISCE stands as a prominent education board in India, empowering students to build and secure their careers through in-depth knowledge and proficiency in English.

The ICSE educational network in Kerala comprises a total of **168** schools, which are strategically distributed with a higher density in the southern and central regions. Ernakulam serves as the primary hub for this curriculum, leading the state with 32 schools, followed by Thrissur with 23, Thiruvananthapuram with 19, and Kollam with 18. The presence of ICSE institutions is more moderate in districts like Kottayam (17), Pathanamthitta (16), and



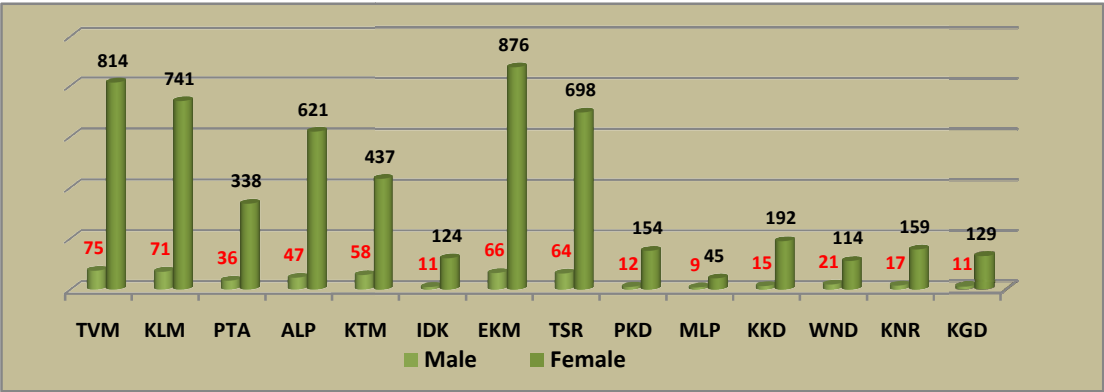
Alappuzha (13). In contrast, the northern and high-range districts show a much smaller footprint, with Palakkad, Kozhikode, and Wayanad each containing 5 schools, while Idukki, Kannur, and Kasaragod have only 4 institutions each. The curriculum has its most limited reach in Malappuram, which records only 3 schools statewide. Number of ICSE schools shows a slight increase from the previous academic year, 2023-24, which had 167 affiliated schools, with the addition of one newly affiliated school located in the Thrissur district. All these schools are private unaided, 99 in rural areas and 69 in urban areas. 81 ICSE schools are high schools and the remaining 87 ICSE schools offer higher secondary education. 161 ICSE schools offer pre-primary classes.

The ICSE student population in Kerala consists of **116,714** students, with a nearly even distribution between **59,454** boys and **57,260** girls. Geographically, the highest concentration of students is found in Kollam, which leads the state with 18,439 students, followed closely by



Thiruvananthapuram with 18,048 and Ernakulam with 17,433. Other districts with significant enrollment include Thrissur and Alappuzha, which host 14,217 and 13,179 students respectively. In contrast, several districts maintain much smaller ICSE student bodies, notably Malappuram, which has the lowest enrollment in the state with only 686 students. Regional enrollment is also comparatively low in Idukki (2,368), Kasaragod (2,422), and Wayanad (2,963), reflecting a curriculum that is primarily centered in Kerala's southern and central urban corridors.

The teaching faculty within Kerala's ICSE schools is composed of **5,955** professionals, characterized by a significant gender imbalance where **5,442** are female and only **513** are male.



Geographically, the largest concentration of teachers is found in Ernakulam with 942 staff members, followed by Thiruvananthapuram with 889 and Kollam with 812. Other districts with substantial teaching bodies include Thrissur (762) and Alappuzha (668). Conversely, the workforce is smallest in Malappuram, which employs only 54 teachers. Additional districts with relatively low faculty counts include Idukki and Wayanad, each recording 135 teachers, and Kasaragod with 140. This distribution highlights that the majority of the ICSE teaching workforce is concentrated in the state's southern and central urban centers.

The following table provides a comprehensive breakdown of the number of schools, students, and teachers in ICSE Schools.

4. Categorization of Educational Institutions under the CBSE Framework

In Kerala, while the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) is the overarching academic board, the schools affiliated with it are broadly categorized based on their administration, funding, and target demographic. The three main pillars of CBSE education in Kerala are Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNV), KendriyaVidyalayas (KV), and Independent (Central Govt, State Govt, Private) CBSE Schools. Each serves a distinct purpose within the state's educational landscape. For the year 2024 – 25, there are 1422 CBSE syllabus schools (excluding JNVs and KVs), 38 KendriyaVidyalayas (KV) and 14 Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNV). Both KendriyaVidyalayas and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas follow the CBSE syllabus. KendriyaVidyalayas primarily serve the children of employees of the central government, including defense personnel and paramilitary forces. Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas, on the other hand, are residential schools primarily for talented

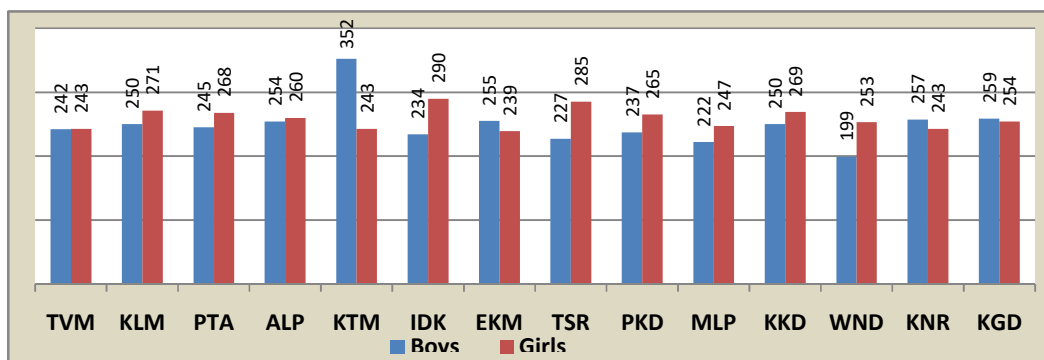
students from rural backgrounds. These schools constitute a smaller fraction of the other syllabus schools in the state. An analysis on each category is described below.

4.1 Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV)

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) is a system of central schools for talented students predominantly from rural areas in India, targeting gifted students who lack access to accelerated learning due to financial, social and rural disadvantages. They are run by Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti, an autonomous organization under the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education. JNVs are fully residential and co-educational schools affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), with classes from **VI** to **XII**. A comprehensive district-wise statistical breakdown of these figures is provided in the table below.

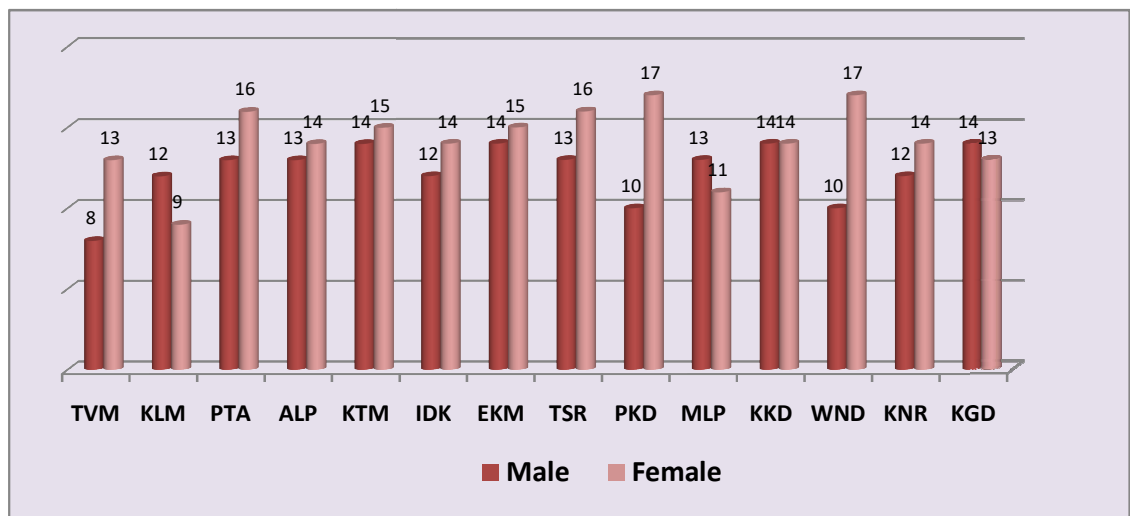

There are total **14** JNVs in Kerala, one in each district. In the academic year 2024-25, JNV schools have **7113** students in classes 1 to 12 and **5271** students in classes 1 to 10. The district with the highest number of students is Kottayam (595 students), followed by Idukki (524 students). The district with the lowest number of students is Wayanad (452 students). The number of students in JNV is more or less the same in all districts (may be because every district has one JNV each).



The bar diagram given below shows the district wise number of male and female students in JNVs

The data reveals a total workforce of **370** teachers across the state, with a clear majority being female. Female teachers account for **198** (53.5%) of the staff, while male teachers make up **172** (46.5%). This trend of higher female representation is consistent inmost districts, most notably in Palakkad (PKD) and Wayanad (WND), where female teachers (17) significantly outnumber their male counterparts (10). Conversely, districts like Kollam (KLM) and Malappuram (MLP) show a higher concentration of male teachers. The bar diagram given below shows the district wise number of male and female teachers in JNVs.



4.2 KendriyaVidyalayas (KVs)

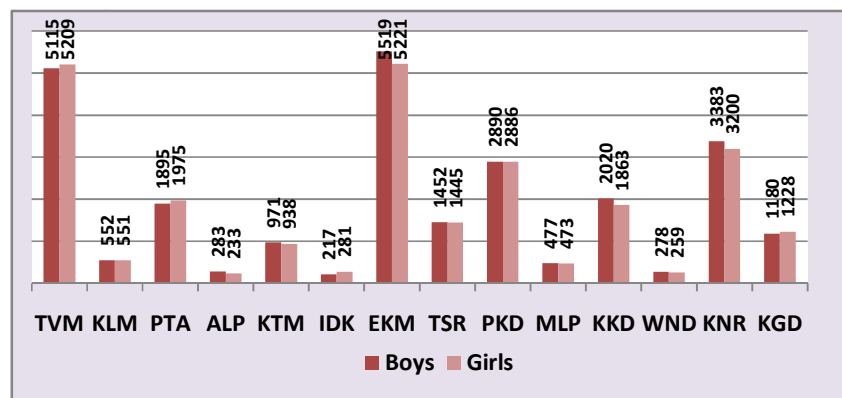
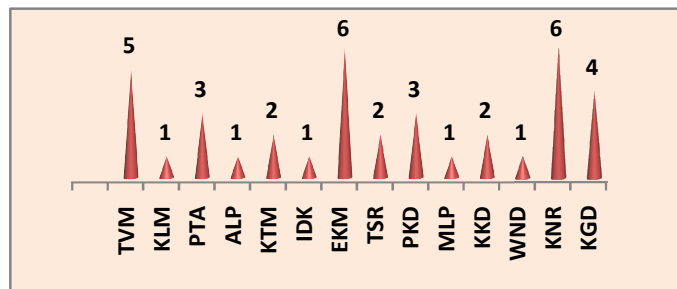
KendriyaVidyalayas (KVs), also known as Central Schools, are a system of premier central government schools in India, established in 1963. Operating under the Ministry of Education, they primarily serve the children of transferable central government employees, including defense personnel and paramilitary forces. KVs are known for their focus on academics, co-curricular activities, and holistic development, playing a significant role in providing quality education at affordable fees and fostering national integration. KendriyaVidyalayas play a significant role in the educational landscape of Kerala, catering to a diverse student population and contributing significantly to the academic and co-curricular development of our children. A comprehensive district-wise statistical breakdown of number of schools, students and teachers is provided in the table below.

The distribution of Kendriya Vidyalayas in Kerala reflects a strategic placement of these central institutions, primarily concentrated in districts with significant administrative, defense, or industrial presence. With a total of 38 KVs listed across the 14 districts, the data reveals a balanced yet slightly skewed distribution toward the northern and southern tips of the state.

Ernakulam (EKM) and Kannur (KNR) emerge as the primary hubs, each hosting 6 schools. Ernakulam's high count is likely due to its status as a commercial and defense center (home to the Southern Naval Command), while Kannur's prominent tally includes significant defense and project-sector schools like those in Ezhimala and Keltron Nagar. Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) follows closely with 5 schools. As the state capital and a major center for defense (Pangode) and space research (VSSC), the high number of KVs here caters to the large population of transferable central government employees. Districts like Kollam (KLM), Alappuzha (ALP), Idukki (IDK), Malappuram (MLP), and Wayanad (WND) have the lowest representation with only 1 school each. In the case of Wayanad and Idukki, this single presence is vital due to their hilly terrain

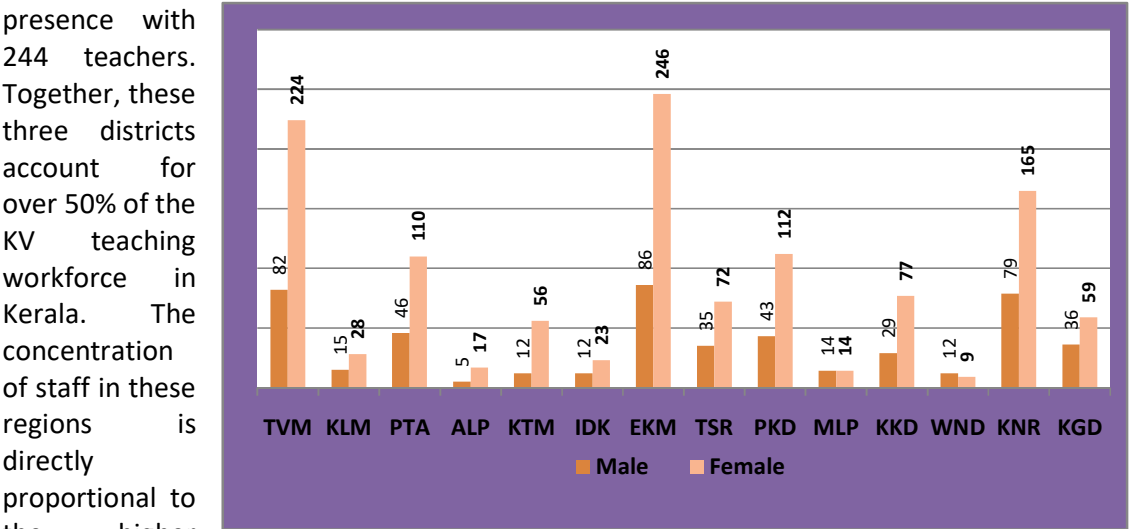


and relatively remote locations.

The total enrollment of students in KVs in Kerala is **51,994** consisting of **26,232** boys and **25,762** girls. The data indicates a healthy and nearly equal gender ratio across the state's central school system. Ernakulam (EKM) and Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) are the clear leaders in enrollment. Ernakulam records the highest overall count with 10,740 students, closely followed by the capital city, Thiruvananthapuram, with 10,324 students. These two districts alone account for nearly 40% of the total KV student population in Kerala, underscoring their status as major hubs for central government and defense personnel. The data highlights a significant disparity in student density between urban/defense hubs and rural or hilly regions. While Kannur remains a strong northern bastion with 6,583 students, districts like Idukki (498 students), Wayanad (537 students), and Alappuzha (516 students) show much lower enrollment. This reflects the presence of only a single Kendriya Vidyalaya in those areas, catering to a smaller, more localized group of central employees compared to the multi-school clusters found in Ernakulam or Thiruvananthapuram.

The workforce supporting these institutions consists a total of **1,718** teachers, comprising **506** male and **1,212** female teachers. This highlights a significant gender disparity, with female teachers outnumbering their male counterparts by a ratio of approximately 5:2. The most striking highlight of KVs is the overwhelming presence of female teachers in almost every district. In major educational hubs like Ernakulam (EKM) and Thiruvananthapuram (TVM), female teachers constitute nearly 74% of the total staff. This trend is even more pronounced in districts like Kottayam (KTM), where female teachers (56) outnumber male teachers (12) by nearly five times. This reflects a broader national trend in the primary and secondary education sectors where teaching is a female-dominated profession.

Consistent with student enrollment and school count data, Ernakulam and Thiruvananthapuram host the largest teaching bodies. Ernakulam leads the state with 332 teachers, followed by Thiruvananthapuram with 306. Kannur (KNR) also maintains a strong presence with 244 teachers.

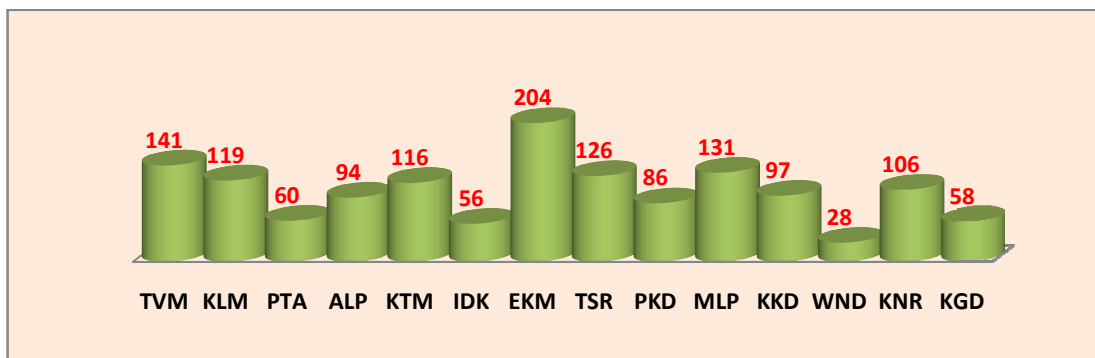


4.3 Independent (Central Govt, State Govt, Private) CBSE Schools

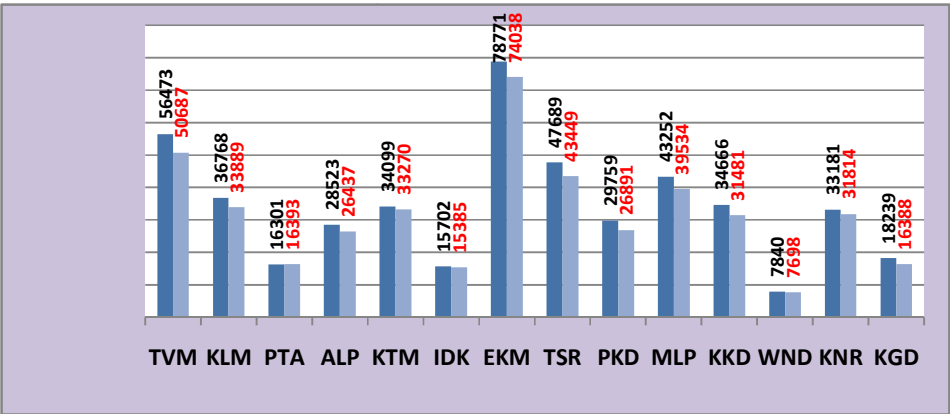
The table given below provides a detailed breakdown of CBSE schools (Central Government, State Government and private unaided CBSE schools) across the 14 districts of Kerala, revealing significant regional disparities in educational infrastructure. Ernakulam (EKM) stands out as the primary hub with the highest number of schools at 204, followed by the capital district, Thiruvananthapuram (TVM), with 141 institutions. In contrast, hilly and less urbanized regions show much lower figures, with Wayanad (WND) recording the state's minimum of only 28 schools. The data suggests a concentration of CBSE-affiliated private education in the central and southern urban corridors, specifically in districts like Thrissur (TSR), Kollam (KLM), and Malappuram (MLP), which all maintain counts above 115. Meanwhile, districts such as Idukki (IDK) and Kasaragod (KGD) remain on the lower end of the spectrum with 56 and 58 schools respectively, highlighting a potential gap in private school accessibility between the state's coastal/midland urban centers and its high-range or northernmost territories.

The diagram given below shows the pictorial representation of district wise number of CBSE schools in Kerala.



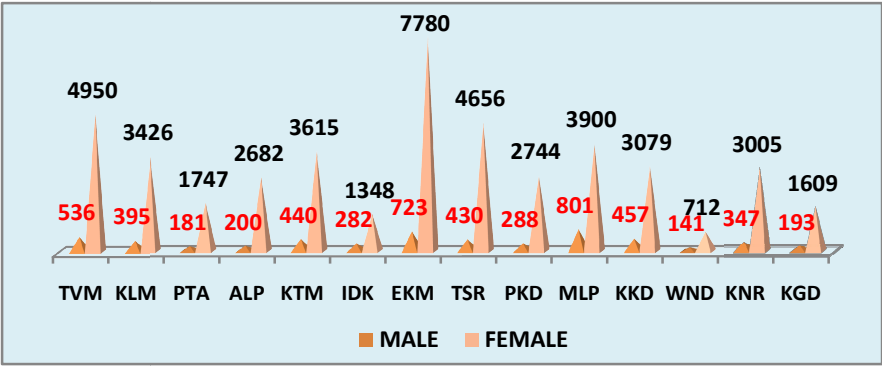
While going to student enrollment in CBSE schools across Kerala, categorized by gender and district. Ernakulam (EKM) emerges as the most significant educational hub, leading the state with a total of 152,809 students, followed by Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) with 107,160 students. Consistent with the school distribution data, Wayanad (WND) shows



the lowest enrollment figures with only 15,538 students total. Across almost every district, there is a

consistent trend of higher enrollment among boys compared to girls, with the notable exception of Pathanamthitta (PTA), where the number of girls (16,393) slightly exceeds the number of boys (16,301). The diagram given below shows the pictorial representation of district wise students enrolment in CBSE Schools.

The distribution of teaching staff in CBSE schools across Kerala, revealing a significant gender disparity within the profession. Ernakulam (EKM) leads the state



with the largest teaching workforce, totaling 8,503 teachers, followed by Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) with 5,486. A striking feature of the report is the overwhelming predominance of female educators; in every single district, female teachers vastly outnumber their male counterparts, often by a ratio of more than 10:1. For instance, in Ernakulam, there are 7,780 female teachers compared to just 723 males. Conversely, Wayanad (WND) records the lowest number of educators, with a total staff of 853, reflecting the smaller number of schools in that region.

5. A discussion on CBSE schools in Kerala according to school management.

Of the **1,422** CBSE schools, **6** are under Central Government management, and **2** are managed by the Kerala State Scheduled Tribes (ST) Development Department as the Nodal Department. The remaining **1,414** schools operate within the private unaided sector. A detailed analysis of these three categories follows

5.1 CBSE School managed by Central Government

The table given below describes the number of schools, students and teachers in Central Government CBSE schools in Kerala. It reveals a highly localized distribution, with only 3 out of 14 districts - Thiruvananthapuram (TVM), Palakkad (PKD), and Kannur (KNR) . Each of these three districts operates 2 schools. Thiruvananthapuram stands out as the primary educational hub, hosting 1,369 students, which constitutes roughly 69% of the total student population . In contrast, Kannur and Palakkad have significantly smaller student bodies with 323 and 280 students, respectively. A demographic analysis shows a consistent trend where male students outnumber female students across all active districts, most notably in Thiruvananthapuram, where boys represent approximately 68% of the enrollment. Regarding the teaching staff, the distribution of the **130** total teachers follows the student density. Thiruvananthapuram employs the largest faculty with 68 teachers, maintaining a perfect gender balance of 34 males and 34 females. Palakkad and Kannur follow with 34 and 28 teachers, respectively. Interestingly, while Palakkad has a higher proportion of male teachers (21), Kannur's faculty is predominantly female (23). The workload distribution varies significantly across the state: Thiruvananthapuram maintains a Pupil-Teacher Ratio (PTR) of approximately 20:1, whereas Palakkad and Kannur enjoy much smaller ratios of roughly 8:1 and 11:1. This suggests that while the capital handles a much higher volume of students, the schools in the northern and central active districts may offer more personalized instruction due to lower student-to-staff ratios.

5.2 CBSE schools with Kerala State ST Department as Nodal Department

The ST Development Department oversees 2 primary CBSE-affiliated institutions in the Thiruvananthapuram district. The first is an Eklavya Model Residential School (EMRS), funded by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA) and managed by the Kerala

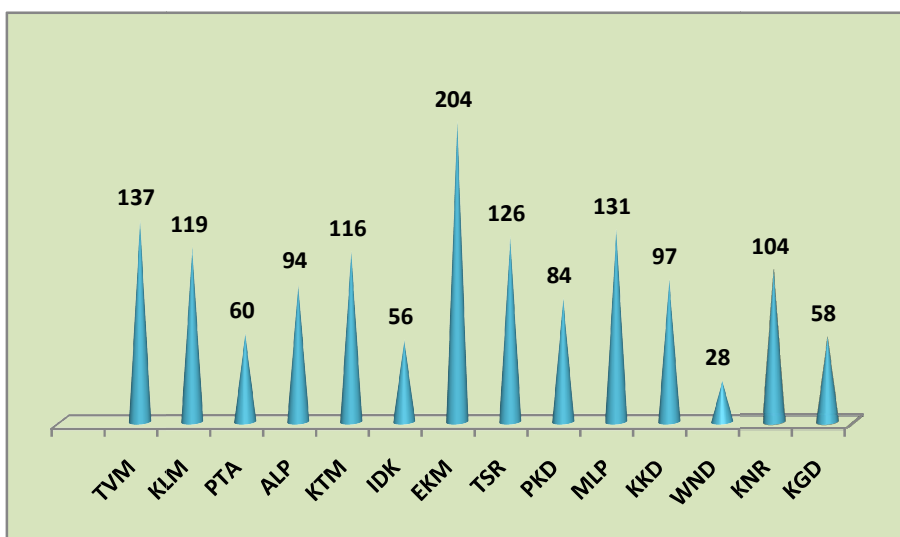
State EMRS Society. The second is a Model Residential School (MRS), established with CBSE affiliation to provide national-level academic standards for tribal students. Collectively, these two schools serve 500 students (230 male and 270 female) and are staffed by 47 teachers (16 male and 31 female).

5.3 Private Unaided Schools affiliated with the CBSE

A total of **1,414** private unaided schools with CBSE affiliation operate across Kerala. These institutions cater to **926,145** students and employ a teaching staff of **50,490**. The district-wise distribution of this data is detailed in the table below.

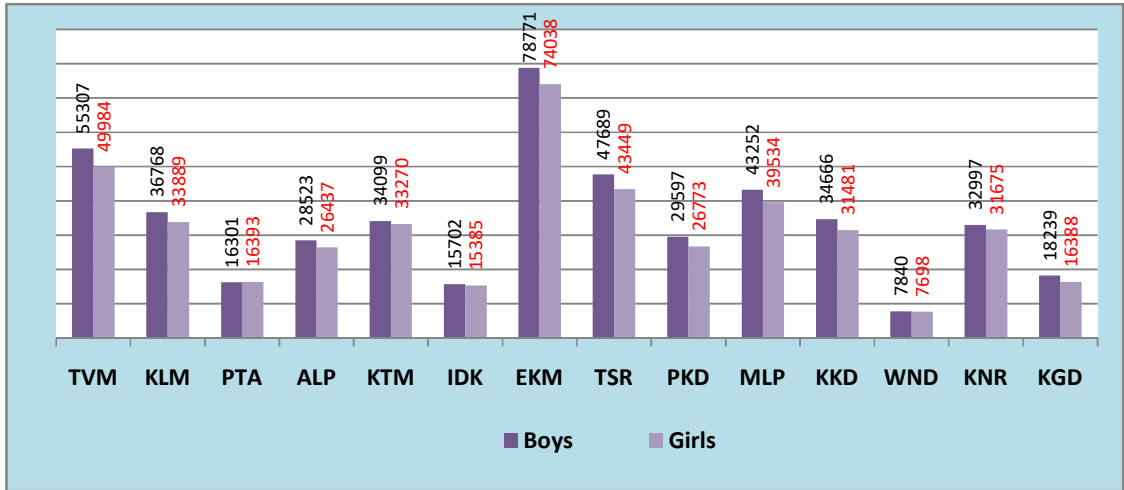

Ernakulam (EKM) leading the state with 204 schools, making it the primary hub for private CBSE education. Following Ernakulam, Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) hosts 137 schools, while Malappuram (MLP), Thrissur (TSR), Kollam (KLM), and Kottayam (KTM) all maintain strong numbers, each exceeding 100 institutions. This broad distribution suggests a high demand for the



CBSE curriculum across both urban and semi-urban centers in Kerala. On the lower end of the spectrum, the hilly and less urbanized districts show a more sparse distribution of private unaided schools. Wayanad (WND) has the fewest institutions with only 28 schools, followed by Idukki (IDK) with 56 and Kasaragod (KGD) with 58. The central and southern regions appear to have a higher density of these schools compared to the northern reaches of the state, excluding Malappuram and Kannur.

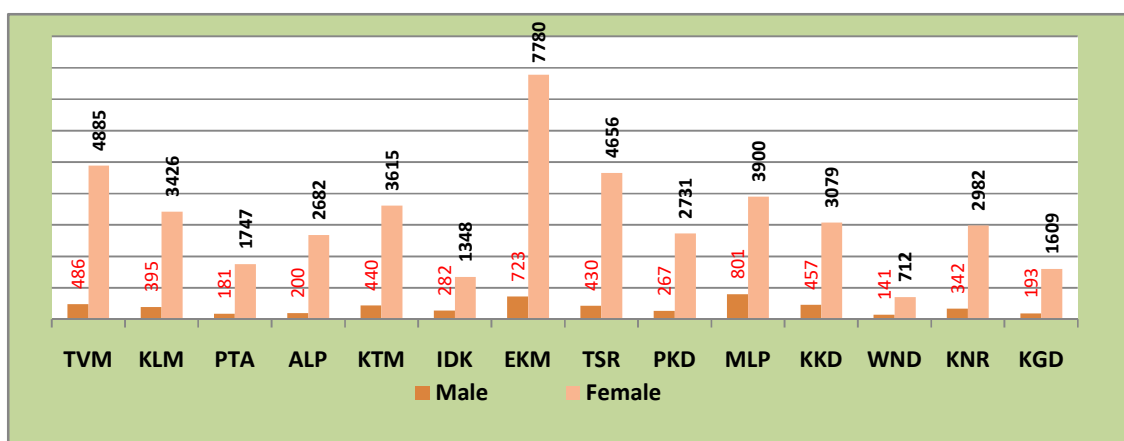
The data regarding student enrollment in private unaided CBSE schools across Kerala reveals a significant educational landscape with a total population of nearly



9,26,145 students. Ernakulam (EKM) emerges as the clear leader in this sector, boasting the highest enrollment with over 1,52,809 students (78,771 boys and 74,038 girls), which aligns with its status as the state's commercial hub. Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) and Thrissur (TSR) also show substantial figures, both exceeding 90,000 total students.

Conversely, the hilly and tribal-majority district of Wayanad (WND) shows the lowest participation in the private CBSE sector, with only 15,538 students in total. From a demographic perspective, the data shows a consistent trend where enrollment for boys slightly exceeds that of girls in almost every district. Pathanamthitta (PTA) stands out as a unique exception in this dataset, being the only district where the number of girls (16,393) marginally surpasses the number of boys (16,301). Overall, the high enrollment numbers in districts like Malappuram, Kollam, and Kottayam - all surpassing 60,000 students underscore the widespread reliance on private unaided institutions for CBSE education throughout the state, particularly in urbanized coastal and central regions.

The statistical data regarding the teaching workforce in private unaided CBSE schools across Kerala reveals a profound gender disparity, with female educators overwhelmingly dominating the sector in every district. Out of a total workforce of **50,490** teachers, female teachers account for more than 90% of the positions.



Ernakulam (EKM) serves as the primary employment hub with a total of 8,503 teachers (7,780 female and 723 male), followed by Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) with 5,371 and Thrissur (TSR) with 5,086. Even in districts with the lowest total staff counts, such as Wayanad (WND) which has only 853 teachers, the ratio remains heavily skewed toward female staff.

A district-wise analysis of male representation shows that Malappuram (MLP) has the highest number of male teachers at 801, which is notably higher than even the more populous Ernakulam in that specific category. In contrast, districts like Wayanad, Pathanamthitta (PTA), and Kasaragod (KGD) report the fewest male educators, all falling below the 200 numbers. The data suggests that while the private CBSE sector is a massive employer within the state's education system, it relies almost exclusively on a female-driven workforce. This trend is consistent across the geographical breadth of Kerala, from the high-density urban centers to the smaller hilly regions, highlighting a systemic characteristic of the private unaided schooling model in the state.

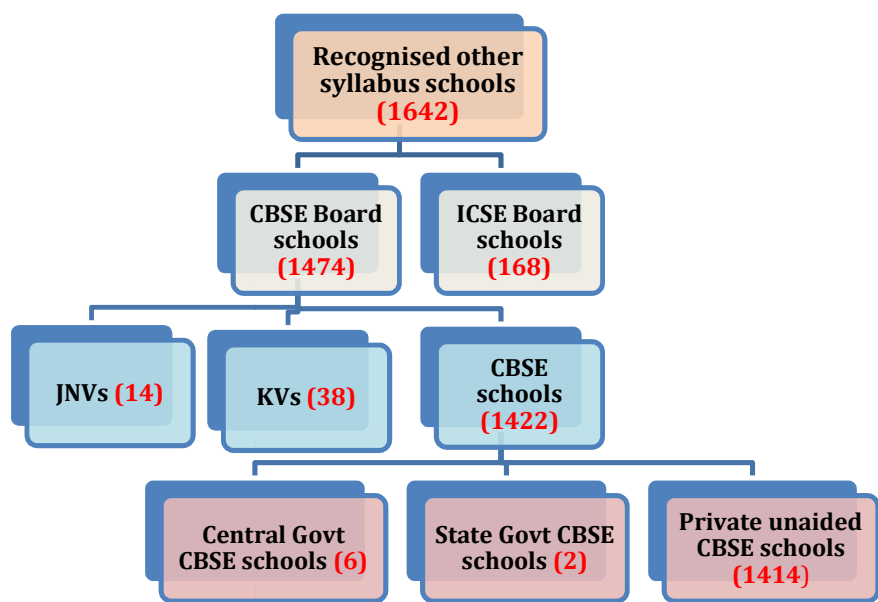
6. Non Teaching staffs in Schools outside the Kerala State Education Board

The non-teaching staff distribution across schools following other syllabi in Kerala is characterized by a significant female majority, with **16,346** females (approximately 63.5%) compared to **9,400** males. This workforce of **25,746** individuals is overwhelmingly concentrated in Private Unaided CBSE schools, which employ **22,869** staff members—nearly 89% of the total recorded. ICSE schools represent the next largest employer with **2,471** staff, while government-run or assisted institutions like Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNV), Kendriya Vidyalayas (KV), and State Government CBSE schools maintain a much smaller non-teaching footprint. Geographically, Ernakulam and Thiruvananthapuram serve as the primary hubs for this workforce, while districts like Wayanad and Idukki show the lowest staffing levels. Notably, while female staff dominates the private sector, male staff are more prevalent in JNV and KV institutions. The following table provides a district-wise breakdown of non-teaching staff across various categories of institutions following a non-state syllabus in Kerala.

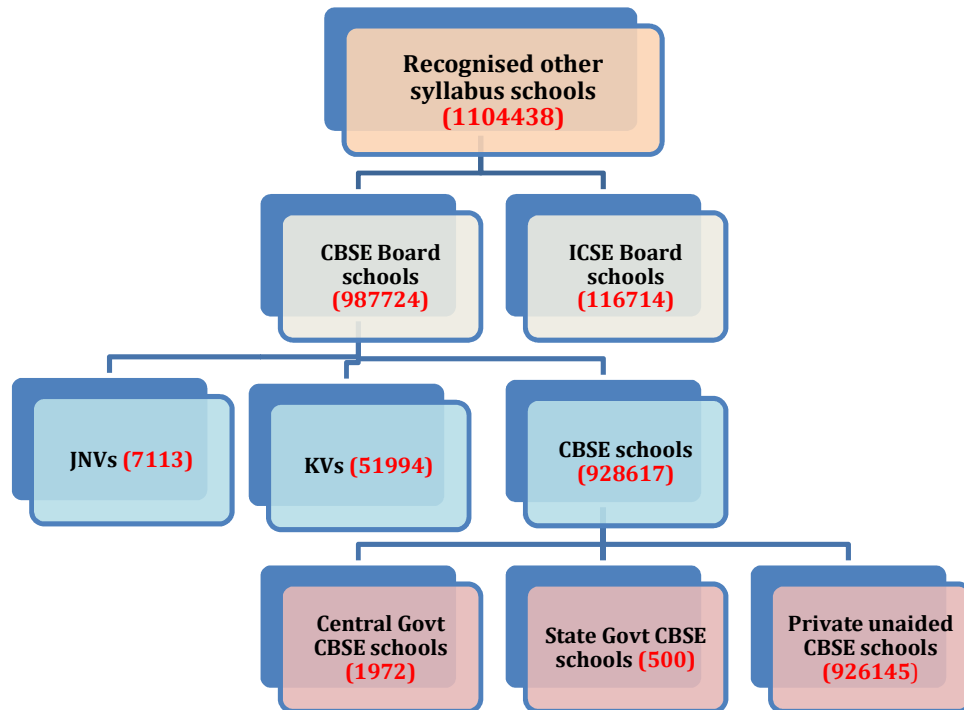

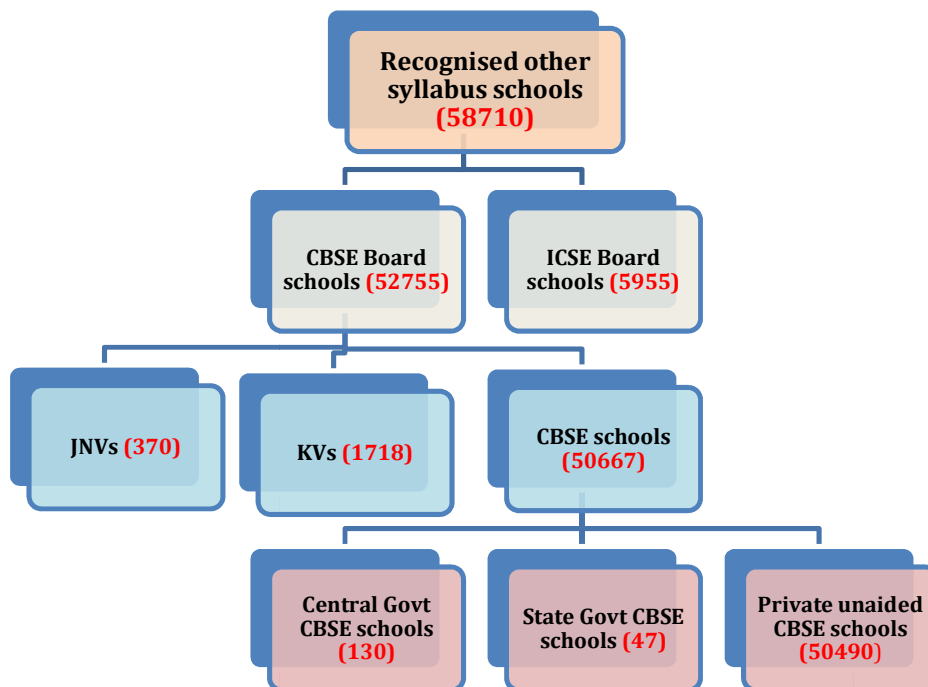
7.1 Number of affiliated schools outside the Kerala State Education Board



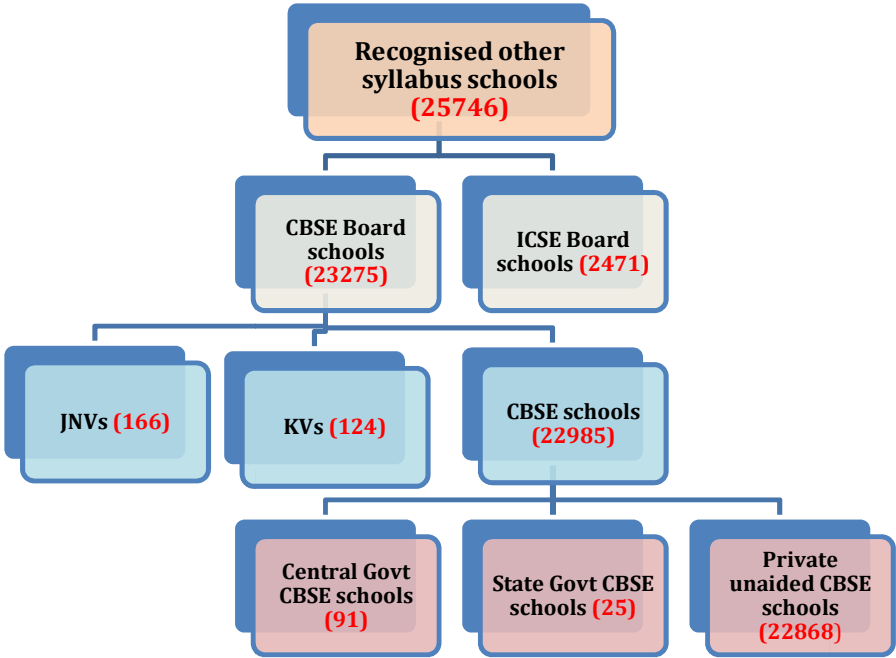
7.2 Number of Students in Recognized other syllabus schools in Kerala
